Tonnage Grain

Total throughput reached 565,353 tonnes in 2008. That represents an increase of 161,996 tonnes over 2007. Furthermore, our grain business has more than doubled since 2004.

Salt and Aggregate

Starting on March 28th with the arrival of the Canadian Navigator, 505,000 tonnes of salt have been received at Port facilities. This is a significant increase over 2007, triggered by harsh weather conditions. As well, 32,378 tonnes of aggregate were shipped through our facility.
