DRYING

- As per Port of Prescott drying charts. High moisture grain requires prior arrangement and may be refused at the discretion of the elevator.

IDENTITY PRESERVATION

- Identity preservation of special binned grain (including storage) for each day or part thereof - all grains - per tonne of wheat equivalent storage capacity in the special bin (refer to Note 3 below) \$0.15

5. All eastern grains will be fumigated upon receipt, other grain at the discretion of the elevator.
6. All Corn Deliveries - corn owner is liable for downgrade on account of CCFM due to breakage from handling in the elevator. See elevator for details prior to delivering corn.

WHARFAGE – PAYABLE BY OWNER OF GRAIN

Vessels loading bulk grain shall pay wharfage at the rate set out in Port of Prescott Wharfage Charges Tariff Notice.

BERTHAGE – PAYABLE BY VESSEL

Berthage charges shall be payable at the rate set out in Port of Prescott Berthage and Anchorage Charges Tariff Notice.

MOORING AND UNMOORING – PAYABLE BY VESSEL – SALTIES ONLY

The Elevator will furnish linesman for mooring and unmooring vessels at the Elevator dock at the following rates per gang:

Monday through Friday:

- When mooring	\$708.13
- When unmooring	\$708.13

After hours, Saturday, Sundays and Holidays:

- When mooring	\$1,060.90
- When unmooring	\$1,060.90

NOTE: The above charges shall include one hour's waiting time. Waiting time in excess of one hour will be at half of the above hourly rate for every hour or fraction thereof.

CALL OUT: In the event a mooring crew is called out and a vessel fails to arrive, there shall be a minimum charge at the above prevailing rates.

SHIFTING OF VESSEL AT DOCK – PAYABLE BY VESSEL – SALTIES ONLY

Shifting time is included in the mooring and unmooring charge, provided the vessel shifts from hold to hold within one hour. Shifting time in excess of one hour will incur an additional mooring charge at the prevailing rate.

STEVEDORING – PAYABLE BY OWNER OF GRAIN – EXCEPTING LAKERS – PAYABLE BY OWNER OF VESSEL

- Loading lakera - per loaded tonne	\$0.26

In addition to the regular rates as set forth in the tariff of Grain Elevator charges, services during other than regular working hours shall be subject to the following overtime charges.

Provided that when gangs have been ordered and are ready to start work, the minimum charges shall be as follows:

2. STAND-BY TIME

- Unloading vessels - per hour	\$1,040.30	\$2,080.60
- Loading vessels - per hour	\$690.10	\$1,380.20

NOTE: Schedule 1 – Applies to normal work days until 9:30 p.m. (Monday through Friday) and for the first four hours on Saturdays.

Schedule 2 – Applies to Sundays, Statutory Holidays, after four hours on Saturdays and after 9:30 p.m. on normal work days.

3. OTHER CHARGES

- For all services performed during other than regular working hours BY ARRANGEMENT
- Stand-by time
 - For any delay in starting or continuing work, provided the delay is not due to any fault of the elevator BY ARRANGEMENT
- Containers (each)
 - Loading containers - regular truck loading elevation bulk heading a container (plus material) \$82.40
 - Trimming charges \$5.15
- The charge for services not specifically mentioned herein shall be BY ARRANGEMENT
